He is now reviewing records of flights from Arizona to Mexico City. Continuing contact with Mexico City surveillance informants MEX-42 and MEX-196, MEX-25 and MEX-55, have pro-duced no further information as to Subject's activities. Review of their surveillance logs indicated the following items of possible interest: Aside from the regular checks of the golf club in Cuernavaca, they also checked the Hotel Posada Jacarandas, which has a small six-hole pitch and putt course, with negative results.
