Surveillance subject's residence 5/20/61 by SAs FRANCIS X. O'BRIEN and LABADIE resulted in subject being observed leaving residence 3:30 p.m. in 1957 Chevrolet, bearing 1961 Fla. license 3-17115, previously determined registered to ROSE F. LONGO, 4214 Riverview Dr., Tampa, who is wife of JAMES COSTA LONGO. JAMES LONGO drive Chevrolet vicinity 2000 block 10th Ave. and was observed alone then and went to Columbia Restaurant.

Surveillance residence 5/21/61 by SAs THOMAS S. LOVERING and LABADIE resulted in subject being observed leaving residence about 6:00 p.m. in same car as above with same person, they went to Columbia Restaurant again and returned subject's residence.

Surveillance residence 5/22/61 by SAs LIONEL E. BELANGER, O'BRIEN and LABADIE, and subject not observed.

[REDACTED] - PCI (protect identity) advised SAs IRWIN FRANK DAVIS on 5/20/61 that even though they resided immediately adjacent to subject's residence, they had not seen him at all in or about his residence.

OTHER 4

[REDACTED] (protect identity), advised SA JOHN D. MEDAGLIA on 5/22/61 that although he resides two homes from subject, has known him all his life, has coffee at the Columbia Restaurant morning and afternoon, he has not seen nor heard subject was in Tampa.

Miami most discreetly check telephone numbers called from private telephone of FRANK RAGANO, subject's attorney, noting he is defense attorney for subjects of numerous FBI cases and only the most discreet inquiry should be made.

SUBJECT SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS  
DUE TO HIS EXTENSIVE PAST ASSOCIATION WITH CRIMINAL ACTIVITIES.
