The Recorder of Deeds Office, in addition, on 12/28/61 reflected that MAX and BETTY EDER executed a mortgage on the above property to the Washington Federal Savings and Loan Association, Miami Beach, Fla., in the amount of \$28,000.00 on 12/19/61, which was filed and recorded 12/20/61.

MM 509-C, on 12/26/61, advised that JOSEPH INDELICATO (Miami file 92-404) has returned to the Patio Bridge Club, Miami Beach, after a long absence and is again playing cards and shylocking out of that club.

DANIEL SULLIVAN, Operating Manager of the Crime Commission of Greater Miami, on 12/28/61 advised he heard Puccini's Restaurant, Miami, Fla., opened on 12/25/61 and so far has complied with all the requests and licenses of JOE FISCHETTI (Miami file 92-99) has the City of Miami. SULLIVAN stated FISCHETTI an interest in this establishment. and his associates remodeled two small buildings into one, which adjoins the property of the restaurant, and apparently intended to use it for a gambling setup. The City of Miami made them tear down part of the new panel walls which covered over the windows and make other corrections, as well as securing a promise that these premises will be used for no other purpose other than a residence for the manager.
