MAX FRIEDSON
INFORMATION CONCERNING
CRIMINAL INTELLIGENCE PROGRAM

Information has been received from British Intelligence authorities that Max Friedson, 415 S. W. 30th Road, Miami, has paid several visits to Nassau and authorities there suspect that he is connected with an American gambling syndicate and may be trying to "salt away" illicitly obtained money in the Bahamas. Friedson is reported to have stated that he represents the "Hughes Syndicate." (S)

Bureau files contain brief information as follows concerning a Max Friedson who may be identical with subject: Bufile 100-363382, MMfile 100-0-11159, contains the report of SA James R. Hunter, Jr., dated 1/20/50 at Mobile, entitled "Progressive League of Florida, Security Matter - C." On page three of this report Max Friedson, 353 Meridian Avenue, Miami Beach, Florida, is listed as the parent of Wilbur Alfred Friedson, then a student at the University of Florida. Bufile 100-383768, MMfile 100-12076, entitled "Andrew Demeter, Security Matter - C," mentions one Max Friedson, not further described, as President of the South Side Democratic Club, Miami, Florida, in 1951.

Miami is instructed to review its files and prepare a letterhead memorandum suitable for dissemination including all public source information available concerning Friedson. Include in the cover airtel all additional background information in Miami files concerning Friedson. P
