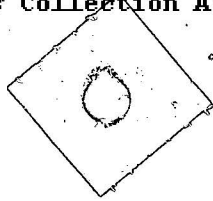
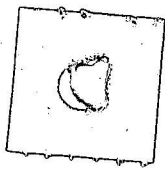

Attached hereto is an editorial appearing in the Chicago Sun-Times of July 11, 1963, which is critical of Police Superintendent O. W. WILSON of the Chicago Police Department, for failure to clean up the "strip and clip" joints in Chicago's Loop and First Ward District. It also is critical of the Chicago Police Department for failure to enforce a local ordinance prohibiting the soliciting of persons to purchase alcoholic beverages.

Veteran crime reporter SANDY SMITH of the Sun-Times, has this week prepared a number of articles exposing the use of B-girls in bars in the First Ward and showing that the proceeds of these bars has been going to the Syndicate. Confidential Informant CG-6649-C, who is herself a "stripper" in these bars, has told us previously that these are local girls working in the bars and are not brought in from out of state.

SANDY SMITH has told us that he has uncovered no evidence of any WSTA or ITAR violations and the Chicago Office has been following this matter closely. We were well aware of all of this information and it has previously been reported in connection with our investigation into the Chicago First Ward and related hoodlums. The connection between Chicago hoodlums and the "joints" in the Chicago area has previously been established.

This matter is being followed closely so in the event there is any violation whereby the FBI can take action against these hoodlums, it will be done.
