Reference is made to the following communications, all captioned "CRIMINAL INTELLIGENCE PROGRAM, CHICAGO DIVISION":

- 1) Bureau airtel to Chicago dated 11/28/61 authorizing Chicago to assign a Special Employee to monitor CG 6486-C* from Midnight to 8:00 a.m. for a two week trial period, beginning with receipt of Buairtel.
- 2) Chicago airtel to Chicago dated 12/8/61 requesting extension of above authorization.
- 3) Bureau airtel to Chicago dated 12/13/61 authorizing a Special Employee to monitor CG 6486-C* from Midnight to 8:00 a.m. for as long as the source is productive during this shift and also noting that in view of the importance of this source, Chicago should assure that it is covered on a 24 hour basis during each day of the week.

As the Bureau is aware, since the above Bureau authority was granted, the Chicago Division has acquired additional coverage from CG 6502-C* and CG 6515-C*, both of which are productive at various times throughout the day, including the Midnight to 8:00 a.m. shift.

In addition, SES assigned to the Consolidated Plant are responsible for CG 6343-C*, which is productive during the daytime hours. Sourced indicated are all misurs.

SEs also handle the clipping of daily newspapers and other periodicals published in the Chicago area.

Chicago presently has five SEs assigned to (monitoring) (K) (u) duties in the (Consolidated Plant) (K) (S). The present (Confile) schedule is as follows: Midnight to 8:00 a.m., Sunday through Saturday, one SE; 8:15 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday, two SEs, with the exception of Saturday, when one SE is assigned this shift; 4:00 p.m. to Midnight, Sunday through Saturday, one SE; for a total of 20 eight-hour shifts, equaling 160 hours of coverage. The 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. shift on Sunday is not covered due to the non-productiveness of this period.

Five SEs, based on a 40-hour week, provide 200 hours of coverage, noting that two SEs are normally assigned Monday through Friday on the 8:15 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. shift, it being noted these are the more productive hours for the sources indicated. Scheduled regular days off for SEs are rotated to afford required coverage.

As of June, 1961, Chicago had six SEs assigned. SE ALBERT W. CARROLL was transferred to New Agents Training School in June, 1961, and at that time SE ROBERT W. THOMPSON of the New York Office was on transfer to the Chicago Office; however, his transfer was cancelled by Bulet to New York dated June 16, 1961. At the time the Chicago Office had six SEs (the plant schedule) required coverage only from 8:15 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and from 4:00 p.m. to Midnight.

In cases of Sick Leave, Emergency Annual Leave or Annual Leave, Chicago must assign only one SE to the daytime shift, which is not desirable due to the productiveness of
