Synopsis: Although ALEX continues to maintain Apartment 31-B, 1300 Lake Shore Drive, with his wife SUZANNE, he has not returned to his residence since he left the U.S. on 6/13/70. Information has been received that ALEX arrived at Fuerstenfeldburck, West Germany, on 7/22/70, from Munich.

DETAILS:

CG T-1 advised that although ALEX has not been seen in the vicinity of the apartment building in which he resides since early June, 1970, he continues to maintain Apartment 31-B, 1300 Lake Shore Drive. CG T-1 advised that no one has been observed in or about the apartment since the early part of June, and that this would include ALEX's wife, SUZANNE, who resides therein with him.

CG T-2 advised that ALEX left the U.S. on June 13, 1970, and that he intended to visit European countries, including Germany. CG T-2 advised that he has no concrete

idea as to the date of the return of ALEX, except that ALEX intended to remain in Europe most of the summer of 1970.

On July 30, 1970, the West German Federal Criminal Police advised that according to a report from the Rural Police Station at Fuerstenfeldburck, West Germany, ALEX arrived at 12 Marthabraeustrasse, in Fuerstenfeldburck, about 8 days previously. According to this report, ALEX arrived by taxi from Munich, West Germany, and Errose FUEGER, the mother-in-law of ALEX, was already staying at that address.
