Sergeant GIUSEPPE LIPPO, Police Headquarters, Rome, Italy, advised on October 6, 1970, that GUS ALEX, in possession of U.S. passport No. 135685, issued at Washington, D. C., on 1/31/68, and his wife, DIETGARD, born December 3, 1938, in possession of passport No. C-1629188 issued at Chicago, Illinois, on 10/31/68, stayed at the Hotel Hassler in Rome from July 6 to July 9, 1970, leaving on that date for an unknown destination.

On August 20, 1970, ALEX and his wife again registered at the Hotel Hassler remaining there until August 25, 1970, when they left Rome for an unkown destination.

According to LIPPO, in checking the records of the Foreigners' Office, Police Headquarters, he noticed that ALEX, traveling with the same passport, was registered at the Hotel Hilton in Rome from June 15 until June 22. 1969.
