Sergeant GIUSEPPE LIPPO, Police Headquarters, Rome, Italy, advised on October 6, 1970, that GUS ALEX, in possession of U. S. passport No. 135685, issued at Washington, D. C., on 1/31/68, and his wife, DIETGARD, born December 3, 1938, in possession of passport No. C-1629188 issued at Chicago, Illinois, on 10/31/68, stayed at the Hotel Hassler in Rome from July 6 to July 9, 1970, leaving on that date for an unknown destination.

On August 20, 1970, ALEX and his wife again registered at the Hotel Hassler remaining there until August 25, 1970, when they left Rome for an unknown destination.

According to LIPPO, in checking the records of the Foreigners' Office, Police Headquarters, he noticed that ALEX, traveling with the same passport, was registered at the Hotel Hilton in Rome from June 15 until June 22, 1969.

The Central Bureau, Criminal Division, Italian National Police, Rome, confirmed on 9-17-70 that GUS ALEX and his wife arrived at Rome's Fiumicino Airport on 8-20-70 aboard Lufthansa flight 342. They took up lodging at the Hotel Hassler in Rome.

The Central Bureau advised that it will communicate to Legat the date of subject's departure from Italy.

The Bureau will be kept advised.

Re Legat, Bonn, phone call 8-24-70 and Bonn airtel to Bureau 8-24-70.

As of 8-31-70 alerted police districts in Italy have been unable to develop any information relating to the arrival in and the travel of ALEX and his wife in Italy. Any information which alerted Italian Police districts may develop will be furnished to the Bureau promptly.

Because of his previous travel to Greece Legat alerted Greek Police sources and was advised on 8-31-70 that the Aliens Directorate, Athens, Greece, has not received any information that subject or his wife has visited Greece. A check was also made of the hotels in Athens and in Piraeus, Greece, without developing any positive information.

Any information which may be developed relating to the travel of ALEX in Italy or Greece will be made available to the Bureau.
