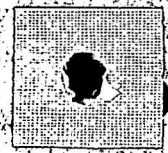

On 1-17-74 the Central Bureau, Criminal Division, Italian National Police (INP), Rome, Italy, advised that its Mafia Section is compiling a hoodlum album which will contain background and criminal information on Italian and Italo-American hoodlums connected with organized crime in Italy and the United States. TRAFFICANTE is scheduled for inclusion in the album.

All of the information furnished to Rome to date has been made available to the Italian police. However, to assist the INP in its current project, the Tampa Office is requested to furnish any current information regarding TRAFFICANTE such as residence, employment, arrests or convictions and any information which links him with organized crime.
