The New Orleans Office has been following the gambling activities being conducted at the Old Southport Club located in Jefferson Parish.

On 2/25/64, Bureau Agents observed that approximately 11:00 P.M. at the parking lot at the Old Southport Club that the parking lot at the Old Southport Club was approximately one half full of parked automobiles and that there was a small crowd of individuals at the Southport Club.

NO 1248PC, a New Orleans gambling figure, advised that the gambling business at Old Southport in the past several months has fallen off so badly that the operators are not making money and the only customers the club is getting are cab drivers and old ladies who play roulette.

NO 1248PC advised that the operators are seriously considering the complete closing of the club, even before
