Re Tampa airtel to Bureau dated 3/8/63.

The Houston Office has advised that review of their case "JOSEPH PERRONE, aka. AR", Houston file 92-190, disclosed no information indicating that subject met with JOSEPH PERRONE somewhere in Texas in March, 1962.

On 3/11/63 TP 60-C stated that he had been recently contacted by HENRY TRAFFICANTE, subject's brother. HENRY TRAFFICANTE is a recent releasee from Florida State Prison at Raiford and during the contact with the informant, HENRY TRAFFICANTE indicated that he carried a message from JOSEPH GARTNER SAN FRATELLO presently an inmate at Raiford. He stated that he had secured the job presently held by SAN FRATELLO in the Prison Hospital and that SAN FRATELLO was crying that he was broke. TRAFFICANTE stated that SAN FRATELLO said that the informant was holding \$2200.00 which represented a settlement on the Driftwood Supper Club formerly operated by SAN FRATELLO in Tampa. Informant told TRAFFICANTE that that was not true as the settlement had not been made as yet but that he expected it in the future. TRAFFICANTE stated that he had other messages from SAN FRATELLO and would drop by and see the informant in a few days. Informant hopes to be able to elicit information concerning subject from HENRY TRAFFICANTE.
