Gus ALEX - Anti-Racketeering

Referring to the above and your office memorandum of February 9, 1961, please be advised that the manifest of Air France, Montreal, P.Q. reveals that a Mr. Gus, no other name available, arrived at Dorval Airport, Dorval, Quebec, on flight No. OOl at 7 p.m. January 30, 1961. The records of Air France did not indicate if ALEX had departed Canada for Detroit, U.S.A. It was ascertained that had he been in possession of a direct passage for Detroit and stopped over in Montreal in transit no record of his departure would be kept in Montreal.

- 2. The lost and found records of Air France reveal that subject had lost a piece of baggage while en route to Canada and he left instructions that if same was located it should be forwarded to Mr. Gus ALEX, 9353 South Spalding, Evergreen Park, Illinois.
- Enquiries through the Ritz Carlton Hotel, Montreal met with negative results.

In view of the foregoing we are concluding our file unless advised to the contrary.
