CRIMINAL INTELLIGENCE PROGRAM INTERVIEW PROGRAM CHICAGO DIVISION

During the month of November, 1963, the following Chicago hoodlums were interviewed by agents of the Chicago Division:

TONY PEROTTI, lieutenant of WILLIAM DADDANO and owner of Mr. T's, Mundelein, Illinois, was interviewed on November 6, 1963. He exhibited a friendly attitude and admitted spending ten years in the Syndicate. He claimed he has been out of touch for the past two years. He declined to furnish any information coming to his attention during the time he was associated with the outfit.

On November 8, 1963, AMERICO DE PIETTO, well-known Chicago hoodlum who was recently arrested on a narcotics charge, was interviewed. Information had been received that he was going to be "hit" and when informed of this he said, "Well, you can't live for ever." He had nothing of value to say and that he had not been doing anything and, therefore, there was no reason why anyone would want to kill him.

On November 18, 1963, ALEX BEN PONZIO, owner of Town Parking, was interviewed. He is the son-in-law of PAUL "The Waiter" DE LUCIA, well-known Chicago hoodlum. PONZIO was courteous but firm in declining to furnish any Information previously received that PONZIO information. might be susceptible to an interview at this time.
