On 9/18/67 Deputy USM MICKEY NEWBERGER, MDF, advised was in receipt of USDC subpoenas for SANTO TRAFFICANTE, Jr. and his brothers, FRANK and SAM (SALVATORE). NEWBERGER advised that the subpoenas were in connection with a civil suit and therefore, SANTO had to be served within the confines of the MDF and that instructions had been received that the two brothers were not to be served until SANTO had been served, as was felt to serve the other two might alert SANTO and make it difficult to find him in the Middle District.

Subsequently, early AM, 9/21, TP 120-C advised that SANTO had returned to the Tampa area during the day, September 20, but for security reasons, informant had been unable to advise Tampa Office until early AM 9/21. SA's of the Tampa Division thereafter placed TRAFFICANTE under surveillance and advised Deputy USM NEWBERGER of TRAFFICANTE's presence in the Tampa, Florida area and subsequently, at 1:12 PM, NEWBERGER personally served TRAFFICANTE in TRAFFICANTE's 2505 Bristol Avenue residence.

On 9/22 NEWBERGER advised that he had, on the morning of 9/22/67, located and served FRANK TRAFFICANTE at FRANK TRAFFICANTE's residence, 705 West Alfred but had been unable to locate SAM TRAFFICANTE although the
