By letter dated 6/14/66, Richmond made available letter received by SA CLARK L. NEWTON from one FRANK W. SEARS, JR., Texas Department of Corrections. In the letter, SEARS indicated soon to be released and had been offered employment with the TRAFFICANTE brothers upon his release. For Bureau's information, NEWTON was formerly resident agent at St. Augustine, Fla., and handled numerous interview at the Florida State Prison (FSP), Raiford, Fla., and although doesn't recall SEARS, presumes SEARS is a former inmate since SEARS mentions an FSP employee.

By letter dated 7/12/66, Tampa requested that Houston interview SEARS for whatever information he might be able to furnish concerning SANTO TRAFFICANTE, JR., and/or TRAFFICANTE's brothers.

Mr. RUBEN CAUSA, Casino Manager, Flamboyan Hotel, Santurce on June 6, 1966.

On June 6, 1966 records of the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office, reflected that one MANUEL ERNESTO VALDEZ having address 3718 McBerry, had been arrested March 31, 1963 for possession of lottery and conducting a lottery and at the time of arrest he had listed his date of birth as June 17, 1924 at Havana, Cuba. Records further reflect on January 25, 1965 this individual had been placed on 2 years probation after originally having been sentenced on May 20, 1963 to serve one year in jail.

On June 8, 1966 TP T-3 viewed a photograph of ART PRICE, also known as ARTURO MISURACA and stated does not associate this individual with SANTO TRAFFICANTE and to his knowledge has never heard any of SANTO TRAFFICANTE's associates speak of ART PRICE.

On May 25, 1966 TP T-8 advised that although he is of Italian descent and his family originally came from Sicily, it so happens that his family is the only family from a particular section of Sicily and is not from the part of Sicily where the TRAFFICANTE's originated. TP T-8 stated that several years ago he had been a member of the Italian Club in Tampa and had become a very close personal friend of SANTO TRAFFICANTE. TP T-8 stated that he was so friendly that SANTO had at one time offered to underwrite all of TP T-8's medical expenses in connection with an operation which he, TP T-8, had had. TP T-8 stated he always considered SANTO TRAFFICANTE as an individual on whose words you could rely and although he has heard many times that TRAFFICANTE is engaged in gambling operations he has no personal knowledge concerning any such activity. TP T-8 stated that he had never heard the name La Cosa Nostra until about 3 years ago but of course heard on many occasions of the "black hand". TP T-8 stated that he had heard of the "black hand" prior to coming to Tampa but has no specific information concerning the organization and could not swear that TRAFFICANTE was ever a member of the "black hand".
