Reference is made to our previous communications in the captioned matter, particularly to our communication dated May 19, 1967, which transmitted a number of photographs depicting the recovery of the buried explosives by Mexican # authorities.

On May 25, 1967, our representative in Mexico furnished the following information: (4)

The explosives recovered from the burial place in the State of Tamaulipas, Mexico, are in the custody of the Mexican Army in Mexico City. The possibility of having the explosives presented at a trial within the United States together with a competent witness from the Direction Federal de Seguridad (Federal Security Police <u>-</u> DFS) or the Army has been proposed **3** to the Mexican Government

On May 25, 1967, of the DFS, and Rafael Hernandez Ochoa, Under Secretary of Government (Interior), advised that no decision has been reached as the matter is very sensitive politically. is a feeling that the DFS should not be compromised in this matter even though they are anxious to see the subjects prosecuted. While it might be possible for Mexican Army demolition experts to testify, this also poses political problems which require further thought.

Our representative noted that the final decision in this matter may rest with the presidency. $\mathcal{L}(u)$
