On 4/30/63, Pittsburgh requested New York to contact JOSEPH VALACHI (protect) to determine whether any additional Pittsburgh individuals other than FRANK AMATO, GABRIEL MANNARINO or SEBASTIAN JOHN LA ROCCA were known to be members of LA CAUSA NOSTRA.

The source of DAVE WALLACE, Allegheny County Police Officer, Pittsburgh, Pa., who was mentioned in the details of this report, has been identified as Mrs. WILLIAM CONSTANZO, Marshall Avenue, Fox Chapel, Pa., who allegedly is closely associated with GABRIEL MANNARINO.

PG 668-PC is presently incarcerated and has been deleted from the Top Echelon Criminal Informant Program, therefore, was not interviewed.

PG 674-PC was interviewed on 2/7/63 and readily discussed his legitimate enterprise but refused to discuss racket activities and personalities.

It is to be noted that while the investigative periods in this case are extensive, it has been maintained in a current status through communications with other offices and continuous investigation.
