On 3/24/61, PG 612-C advised SA THOMAS G. FORSYTH, III as follows:

During the evening of 3/21/61, one JIMMY (LNU) from Youngstown, Ohio, described only as about 40 years of age, 6 feet tall, medium - heavy build, and dark hair and complexion, dropped into the City News, 859-3rd Avenue, New Kensington, Pa., a numbers writing joint. JIMMY asked for SAM LANZINO, a local fence, and was told that LANZINO had not been in yet. As he was leaving, he said that LANZINO should be told that "JIMMY from Youngstown" wanted to see him and would be at the Bachelor's Club, a MANNARINO controlled after-hours gambling-drinking joint in New Kensington. JIMMY was driving an undescribed car with Ohio license J79M.

This JIMMY is supposed to be a friend of JOSEPH "RED" GIORDANO, long-time MANNARINO associate-employee. About six months ago, JIMMY met LANZINO in New Kensington and held some sort of indistinctly heard conversation regarding men's suits.

On 3/23/61, a black 1960 Cadillac sedan, bearing Pennsylvania license 993-257, was observed by SA FORSYTH parked in front of the residence of GABRIEL MANNARINO, 540 Charles Avenue, New Kensington. It was determined that this car was registered to JEAN MANNARINO, wife of GABRIEL.
