Regular contact has been maintained with FLORENCIO VIVAS, Agent, Mexican Immigration Service, who has been attempting to locate NORBERTO FUENTES GARCIA, who was last known to have the address Calle San Juan de Letran, 13, but no information has been developed by VIVAS as to the possible whereabouts of FUENTES. VIVAS, when last contacted on 4-16-62, advised that he was continuing efforts to attempt to locate FUENTES and that a review of the Immigration file on FUENTES reflects that in November and December, 1960, FUENTES claimed to be the Caribbean representative of the Webster Outdoor Advertising Company of Miami, Florida, and that FUENTES was born 1-8-12 at Manzanillo, Cuba.

For the information of the Miami Office, the subject of this case, according to the Tampa Office, has been described publicly in Tampa newspapers as a "king pin" in the Bolita racket. A reliable source of the Tampa Office advised on 7-18-61 that the subject had been in communication with NORBERTO FUENTES GARCIA and the Tampa Office is interested in establishing the identity of FUENTES along with any information establishing his connection, with any, with the subject.
