On 6/18/59 Dr. ALFRED CARREL, Swiss Central Police Bureau, Bern, Switzerland, reported that investigation at St. Moritz, Switzerland, has failed to show that GUS ALEX was in that locality during March 1959. Further, additional inquiry by the Swiss has revealed that it appears improbable that subject was involved in the burglary of a jewelry shop at St. Moritz, Switzerland, March 4, 1959. The Swiss now believe that this burglary was the work of Italian hoodlums.

As soon as the results of additional inquiry at St. Moritz, particularly the results of fingerprint comparison and display of ALEX' photograph is received, the Bureau will
