ANTI-RACKETEERING

Re Chicago letterhead memorandum 4/24/59.

This is to advise that a copy of referenced Chicago memorandum was furnished to the Prefecture of Police, Paris, on 5/12/59, together with a request that VIVIANE GREYMOUR be interviewed regarding her association with either MARIANNE or GUS ALEX.

Mr. GEORGE CLOT, Prefecture of Police, Paris, advised on 6/30/59 that investigation has disclosed that VIVIANE GREYMOUR is the Style Editor of "Le Figaro" newspaper, one of the leading newspapers of Paris. He advised that since Miss GREYMOUR is a journalist, it is not considered advisable to interview her regarding her association with MARIANNE or GUS ALEX. He suggested that adverse publicity could result from such an interview.

In view of the reluctance of the police to interview Miss GREYMOUR, it is not believed that this lead should be covered.

This case is continued in a pending status to report the result of investigation at St. Moritz, Switzerland.
