He advised that investigation at St. Moritz, Switzerland, has been completed and that no further pertinent information was obtained which would indicate that the subject was involved in the burglary at St. Moritz. Mr. GUERON advised that their file has been closed and no further investigation is being conducted regarding ALEX.
