CG SIX FOUR FOUR THREE DASH C ADVISED THAT HE HAD RECEIVED INFORMATION THAT ALEX USES THE COLUMBIA CURRENCY EXCHANGE LOCATED IN THE VICINITY OF CERMAK ROAD AND INDIANA AVENUE, CHICAGO, FOR CASHING CHECKS IN THE PAST. INFORMANT STATED THE CURRENCY EXCHANGE IS RUN BY AN INDIVIDUAL NAMED FIRST NAME UNKNOWN KRAVITZ. INFORMANT SAID THAT KRAVITZ HAD HANDLED LARGE SUMS OF MONEY ON OCCASION FOR GUS ALEX AS WELL AS HIS HOODLUM ASSOCIATE, FRANK FERRARO. INFORMANT SAID IN ALMOST EVERY INSTANCE, KRAVITZ WOULD CASH CHECKS AT THE CURRENCY EXCHANGE WITHOUT BENEFIT OF ENDORSEMENT FOR ALEX AND MANY OF ALEX-S ASSOCIATES.

INFORMANT FURTHER ADVISED THAT FIRST NAME UNKNOWN ENDLEMAN OF THE REVERE CAVERA COMPANY, AND WHO FORMERLY ACTED AS AN AUDITOR AND PRIVATE SECRETARY FOR TED BRISKIN, HANDLED ON OCCASION AS MUCH AS ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS A WEEK IN PAYMENTS FOR HIS BETTING LOSSES TO THE BRAVOS
