ever owning any Webcor-Dormeyer stock. He said he is not acquainted with MARIANNE RYAN and did not know she was a former wife of ALEX. HAFFA stated that a check of the current stockholders of Webcor Corporation disclosed that ALEX had no stock in the corporation in his name.

VIII. MISCELLANEOUS

CG T-29 advised that he had received information that ALEX plans again this year to travel and vacation in Europe, as he has for the past two years. Informant said that ALEX may also buy a Mercedes Benz while in Germany, and use this to travel in Europe. Informant said that ALEX may also attempt to bring this Mercedes Benz back to the United States with him after he completes his vacation. CG T-32 advised that he had received information during the early part of October, 1962, that ALEX also complained that he may possibly lose his auto license because of improper registration. It is to be noted that during the early part of October, 1962, approximately ten Chicago hoodlums had their auto licenses revoked because of improper registrations, and for this reason ALEX was probably concerned over the possible revocation of his license.

The West Germany Federal Criminal Police advised that the Munich, Germany Criminal Police had attempted to interview HELMUT MAIER, ex-husband of SUZANNE FUEGER, in effort to obtain from him any information he may have regarding the activities of ALEX. The Munich, Germany Police advised that MAIER's employer was contemplating on establishing MAIER as his export agent in New York City toward the latter part of 1962, or the early part of 1963, and that MAIER could possibly be contacted regarding ALEX at that time.

During a surveillance of ALEX by agents of this office in the early part of September, 1962, ALEX indicated to a passing motorist that they knew each other. It was determined from the registration of the motorist to whom ALEX waved to that this person was MILES FLEISHMAN. FLEISHMAN
