Additional information concerning the arrival of ALEX in Switzerland as received in reBucab was also promptly furnished the SCPB. On 12/23/62 the Zürich Cantonal Police reported that attempts to confirm ALEX's arrival or presence in Zurich had been unsuccessful. On 12/28/62, on the basis of information received from Legat, Bonn, Dr. FRANZ WALTERSKIRCHEN, General Directorate of Public Safety, Ministry of the Interior, Vienna, Austria, was informed that indications had been received that ALEX might have been or be staying at the Grand Hotel, Kitzbühel, Austria. Dr. WALTERSKIRCHEN stated that he would immediately take steps to check whether ALEX was in Kitzbünel, and if there, to endeavor to ascertain when he would leave, for what destination, and by what means, as well as any contacts he may have made while there. He added that he would inform Legat, Bern as soon as he obtained this information.
