Re Bonn cable 1-19-63 and Bonn Airtel 12-28-62.

On 2-1-63 the BKA (Bundeskriminalamt - West German Federal Criminal Police) furnished the following information:

By letter dated 1-24-63, the State Criminal Police of Bavaria at Munich, Germany, informed the BKA that the person represented on a photograph of SUSANNE or DIETGARD FUEGER (previously provided to the BKA by this office) is beyond a doubt the woman who visited Mrs. ELROSE FUEGER at Riederau, Bavaria, during the week beginning 12-17-62. This woman left Riederau on 12-21-62 or 12-22-62, allegedly to go skiing in Switzerland. The place to which she proceeded could not be ascertained. At the time of this visit in Riederau, she was not accompanied by the subject. Reportedly she intended to again visit her mother in Riederau before returning to the United States.

The Bavarian Police also informed the BKA that the police of Fuerstenfeldbruck had determined that after the subject and SUSANNE FUEGER had arrived at the Munich Airport from Vienna on 1-18-1963, they had traveled by car to the home of ELROSE FUEGER in Riederau, arriving there at about 6:30 p.m. on 1-18-63. Registration data on the car used has not yet been determined, and inquiries are continuing in this regard and to develop, if possible, further information on the subject's movements.
