This source advised that while drinking, claimed to have been a contact of an attorney named Muron, from Shreveport assisted Marcello in being released from police and custody while in Guatemala. also claimed he was instrumental in getting Marcello and Muron out of Guatemala and through arrangements made by \_\_\_\_\_, Marcello was taken by a small boat to an island off the coast of Honduras about 50 or 100 miles where Marcello transferred to another boat which brought him back to the United States. This source advised that he did not obtain any details how this was accomplished but stated he did not wish to appear to be too interested because of personal interests in Guatemala.

Source Two (2) advised that he had an occasion to speak to Marcello and Marcello related how he was deported from <u>Guatemala</u> to <u>El Salvadorewhere</u> he was held in jail for approximately a week and then he entered Honduras where they stayed in a city which has an airport. Attorney <u>Michael Maroun</u> accompanied Marcello on this trip and in <u>Honduras</u>, Maroun registered at a hotel and then departed from Honduras and <u>U.S.M</u> returned to the United States, apparently by air. Marcello remained at the hotel registered as Maroun and stayed there without leaving the hotel because he feared arrest, until he made arrangements to effect his return to the United States. This source advised that Marcello stated that he has but one secret in the world and that is how he got back to the United States, and no one, not even his wife, knows how he did it.

This source advised that at the time of this conversation, Marcello had been drinking and he does not know whether there is any truth to his remarks.
