**CRIME CONDITIONS IN MISSISSIPPI
CRIMINAL INTELLIGENCE PROGRAM
NEW ORLEANS DIVISION**

Re your report 3/8/62 regarding crime conditions in Mississippi.

A review of referenced report indicates several instances where information is attributed to informants which could compromise them. For example, on page 54, T-2 stated in connection with his bar and lounge it cost him \$300 in payoffs the first nine weeks of operation, including initial payments for the privilege of opening a new establishment. In this same paragraph, informant makes reference to Beat Two constables in Harrison County, Mississippi.

On this same page informant advised shortly after opening his establishment he placed slot machines in a back room which belonged to Horace Crane. Constable Clyde Collins thereafter asked informant to use "his" machines if he wished to operate them in the back room of his lounge, to which the informant agreed. Informant advised the machines were subsequently delivered to him by Joe Ready.

You should review referenced report to insure no statements are attributed to informants which could compromise them based on available information in your files. It is important that our confidential sources and informants are protected when attributing information to them to insure their identity will not be revealed at a later date.

This matter should be handled and amended page or pages submitted to reach the Bureau no later than 4/2/62.
