RE CG TELS TO BUREAU JUNE 20, 1975. U

CG 6481-PC ADVISED THAT THE DAY GIANCANA WAS MURDERED, JUNE 19, 1975, DOMINIC BLASI, A LONG TIME ASSOCIATE AND CONFIDANT TO GIANCANA, HAD SPENT A CONSIDERABLE PORTION OF THE DAY WITH GIANCANA. SOURCE ADVISED THAT BLASI NOTED GIANCANA TO BE IN GOOD SPIRITS AND IN APPARENT RELAXED MOOD, INDICATING HE WAS NOT AWARE HE WAS TO BE KILLED LATER THAT EVENING. U

ON JUNE 21, 1975, CHICAGO POLICE DEPARTMENT, WORKING WITH CUSTOMS, O'HARE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, CHICAGO, ADVISED THAT PHYLLIS MC GUIRE, FORMER PARAMOUR OF GIANCANA, HAD JUST CHECKED THROUGH CUSTOMS WITH TEN PIECES OF LUGGAGE. CHICAGO PD INFORMED THAT MC GUIRE WAS JUST RETURNING FROM FRANCE. PHYLLIS MC GUIRE WAS MET AT O'HARE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT BY HOODLUM CHARLES ENGLISH, WHO ESCORTED PHYLLIS MC GUIRE TO CHICAGO FOR APPARENT REASON OF ATTENDING SUBJECT'S WAKE AND FUNERAL. U
