Legat, Mexico City is of the opinion that conditions conducive to a direct approach to GUTIERREZ relative to this matter have not been obtained. Due to the sensitive nature of circumstances relating to this case, it is not wise to attempt an indirect approach to GUTIERREZ through other contacts as suggested by Chicago

In addition, the results of previous discussions with GUTIERREZ BARRIOS on this subject have been reported to the Bureau and Chicago. In Mexico City letter dated 11-5-74, GUTIERREZ BARRIOS is quoted as stating that deportation action was taken against subject because the subject was illegally in Mexico and that this action was not based on any activities of a criminal nature which might be considered in violation of Mexican law. At one point, GUTIERREZ BARRIOS explained the deportation by saying simply that the subject's papers were not in order. Since GUTIERREZ BARRIOS retains a high position in the Mexican Government and has previously furnished an account of the reasons supporting the deportation action against subject, it is doubtful that he would furnish any substantially different information at this time to this office or any other Embassy representative.
