MEX-156, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised 10/25/68 that Mexico City license 335 BE is registered to MIGUEL M. ALCANTARA, Tacubuya 132, Mexico City. (X) U

MARIO GUERRA of the Cuernavaca Police advised 10/22/68, by long distance telephone, that he would soon be in Mexico City and that he had information of pertinence concerning the subject including a possible address in Acapulco. (X) U
