Reference Mexico City letter 10/27/69 and Bureau letter to Mexico City 11/7/69.

On 11/7/69 Mrs. JORGE MUNUZURI of Acapulco, Mexico (protect by request), who has furnished reliable information in the past and furnished information concerning the subject and his activities in Acapulco, advised by letter that subject had returned to Acapulco and was again in residence at the Acapulco Towers. Local rumor has it that he resolved his immigration difficulties through the influence of former Mexican President MIGUEL ALEMAN. *(S)u*

Discreet contact with attorney JORGE VAZQUEZ ROBLES, Chief of the Inspection Service of Mexican Immigration, confirmed that subject had resolved his difficulties with Mexican Immigration and legally returned to Mexico. He noted that subject was never formally expelled from Mexico and that apparently the charges against him were of a somewhat technical nature. *(S)u*

It appears clear that subject had influence in arranging this matter. *u*

It is noted that the "Los Angeles Times" for 10/31/69 reports SIDNEY KORSHAK, who apparently is associated with subject in the Acapulco Towers, as a defendant in the case involving the Parvain-Dohrmann Company. *u*

It is noted that SAM GIANCANA, Bufile 92-3171, reportedly will be spending Christmas at the Acapulco Towers. It is anticipated that a source of this office will be in contact with the subject and GIANCANA at that time. *(S)u*
