ADMINISTRATIVE:

Information from records of General Telephone Company of Florida was made available by Mr. JAMES E. McMAHON, Security Director.

On October 30, 1967, TP 120-C advised SA JOHN A. AMBLER that the Civil Suit involving Mrs. TRAFFICANTE, who was injured in an automobile accident, had not been settled as yet, and that during the time Mrs. TRAFFICANTE was recuperating from the accident, on the expenses to be claimed from an insurance company, the TRAFFICANTE's had paid the household maid by check drawn on Mrs. TRAFFICANTE's account at the Central Bank in Tampa, in the amount of \$28.75. TP 120-C advised that this was a very unusual procedure, as usually the maid is paid in cash and that, in addition, Mrs. TRAFFICANTE wanted the maid to endorse three extra checks so that an additional claim could be made against the insurance company, but the maid would not sign the additional checks. TP 120-C added that both SANTO and Mrs. TRAFFICANTE are in poor health and that SANTO is of the opinion he has cancer of the bowels and has lost considerable weight since the first of the year. TP 120-C added that on a recent occasion TRAFFICANTE's close associate, JAMES COSTA LONGO, was visiting at the TRAFFICANTE residence and the two of them conversed about TRAFFICANTE's brother having recently been called as a witness, on November 24, 1967, TP 120-C advised that the following individuals had been in attendance at TRAFFICANTE's birthday dinner, which had been held at his home, in Tampa, on the night of November 15:

FRANK DIECIDUE and wife;
FRANK RAGANO and wife;
SAM and ELST CATEICANTE;
JIMMY and ROSE TONGO;
Dr. ROYSAXON and wife.

TP 120-C added that on the following day, sometime in the evening, SANTO and Mrs. TRAFFICANTE had left Tampa, driving to Miami in the green car and that prior to leaving, SANTO had indicated he would be in Tampa for Thanksgiving.

-B-COVER PAGE Informant added that Mrs. TRAFFICANTE was next seen in Tampa on Wednesday afternoon and that sometime around 2:00 p.m., TRAFFICANTE's son-in-law, AUGIE, drove to the Tampa International Airport and picked up SANTO. Informant remarked that there was no one at TRAFFICANTE's residence for Thanksgiving dinner except SANTO, Mrs. TRAFFICANTE, MARY JO and her family, and Mrs. TRAFFICANTE's father. Informant remarked that TRAFFICANTE has recently voiced reluctance to driving a car and has stated that the FBI "tail" drives him crazy and that he is afraid that he will have an accident or that they will have him arrested on some traffic charge.

On November 27, 1967, TP 120-C advised that TRAFFICANTE had departed Tampa sometime between 8:00 a.m., November 25, and 1:00 p.m., November 26, 1967, presumably to fly to Miami, and that on Monday morning, November 27, 1967, TRAFFICANTE personally called the Tampa residence and apparently spoke with the maid regarding the whereabouts of Mrs. TRAFFICANTE, and was told that Mrs. TRAFFICANTE was enroute to Miami in the green car.

On November 21, 1967, MM 1209-C advised that GENE MYERS had recently told the informant that he, MYERS, works for SANTO and that he and SANTO had come to Miami for the purpose of ascertaining the identities of those persons who owed Shylock money to recently killed THOMAS ALTAMURA. MYERS also indicated that JOSEPH INDELICATO had been charged with the responsibility of finding the money outstanding and, further, was partially blamed for the killing in that INDELICATO had warned ANTHONY ESPERTI that ALTAMURA intended to kill ESPERTI.

NO 1457-C-TE has advised in the past that MARCELLO and TRAFFICANTE communicate telephonically; however, this informant has not been in a position to furnish the exact details regarding the communications.
