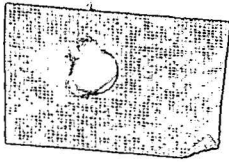

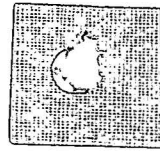

Re Dallas teletype, 3/22/62.

On 3/22/62, DL 149\_C advised that he had been in conversation with J. B. KING, JR., a Ft. Worth gambler, on that date. J. B. KING's reliability is unknown both to the informant and this office. KING told informant that rumors prevalent around Ft. Worth were to the effect that Federal authorities were "putting so much heat on the Police Department and causing a lot of trouble."

SA JOSEPH M. MYERS was mentioned by KING to the informant as being one of the Federal Agents who was investigating Federal crimes in the Ft. Worth area. KING also mentioned to informant that several "higher ups" in the Ft. Worth Police Dept. had been stating that they were going to see SA MYERS' boss in Dallas to get him to "keep his nose out of their business."

The foregoing is for the Bureau's information in view of the potential scandal developing in the Ft. Worth Police Department which has been previously brought to the Bureau's attention. In view of the potentially explosive situation in the Ft. Worth PD, it is not believed desirable for the SAC to pursue this matter; however, it is being closely followed and the Bureau will be advised of any further developments.
