It was overheard by FANO TRAFFICANTE telling NICK SCAGLIONE that this LOU was a close friend of SANTO TRAFFICANTE and that the purpose of the meeting was to resolve the question of a \$100,000 debt owed LOU CAGGIANO as a result of a gambling game at the Congress Inn, Tampa, some time before. CI had been told that as a result of the meeting PARRINO would not pay CAGGIANO the \$100,000 but would repay LOU CAGGIANO a sum between \$7,000 and \$14,000 as previously won by PARRINO from CAGGIANO. On 1/2/63, TP 50-C identified a photo of LOUIS P.
