On 9/18/62, [redacted] PCI (Protect), advised subject was in the Columbia Restaurant, Tampa, at 4:55 P.M. Source advised two unknown white males had been in the restaurant and upon leaving, one of the men spoke to subject. Source said that two men got into a 1961 or 1961 bluish Cadillac bearing 1962 Florida license 6WW-1903.

OTHER 4

On 9/20/62, the same source advised subject's close associate, JAMES LONGO, had been in the Columbia Restaurant on day of September 20, alone.

On 9/24/62, Bureau agents observed LONGO arrive at Columbia Restaurant in the afternoon of 9/24/62, and subject arrived shortly thereafter, had coffee with LONGO, and left alone by 2:45 P.M.

On 9/24/62, PCI [redacted] as above, advised subject was observed at 5:05 P.M., at the Columbia Restaurant and in the company of JAMES LONGO and CASIMIRO B. HERNANDEZ, aka "Casey".

On 9/25/62, agents of the Tampa Office observed JAMES C. LONGO alone in the Columbia Restaurant and on the afternoon of same date observed him on a front porch of, and in contact with, SALVATORE SCAGLIONE, 2301 10th Avenue, Tampa.

Efforts to locate subject in Tampa on 9/25/62 and 9/26/62, through sources and contacts, negative.

On 9/27/62, pretext call made to subject's residence, and usual answer obtained, that residents would have to be contacted after 7:00 P.M.

On the same date subject's wife, JOSEPHINE TRAFFICANTE, observed to leave residence alone, driving white Crysler, and the same time white Chevrolet Impala still in garage, and 1962 Ford usually driven by son-in-law, AUGUST PANIELLO, still at residence.

[REDACTED] PCI, (Protect), maid at subject's residence, advised subject not presently at his residence.

OTHER 4

On 9/27/62, ELMIRA HERNANDEZ, Part-owner, Columbia Restaurant, advised subject has not been around Columbia and LONGO has been alone for several days when at Columbia.

On 9/27/62, JACK de la LLANA, Intelligence Unit, Tampa PD, advised he had received information in the past, to which he had not attached any significance, and he did not know if there was any significance to same, but it was to the effect that the Chief Criminal Deputy Sheriff, LLOYD FRAZIER, at Houston, Texas, had been making inquiries of Tampa PD as to the subject, and de la LLANA stated that subject had been reportedly seen or connected with someone in Houston, Texas, and the Chief Criminal Deputy Sheriff was making general inquiries in the Tampa PD concerning subject's activities. De la LLANA stated he forwarded photograph and background concerning subject to the Sheriff's Office, at Houston, Texas.

On 9/27/62, the Miami Office advised subject had been located in Miami.
