MM T-1 is EVELIO ALPIZAR PEREZ. For the information of the Bureau, ALPIZAR, with his consent, was placed in direct contact with U.S. Customs on 6/14/63. Mr. SHANLEY, of U.S. Customs, subsequently advised that after ALPIZAR landed his plane at the Krome Avenue Farm, he attempted to "blow the whistle" and warn several Cubans who had arrived on the truck, so that they could get away.

Also, Miami files reflect that on 7/19/62, [Mr. RAY DUBOIS], CIA, Miami, advised that CIA then had an operational interest in [CARLOS EDUARDO HERNANDEZ SANCHEZ, born October 15, 1939, Havana, Cuba, residence, 1705 Southwest 3rd Avenue, Miami] (S) (S)

Also, on October 12, 1960, INS submitted the name of VICTOR ESPINOSA HERNANDEZ, born August 26, 1937, Cuba, along with other names, in a list to this office for an indices check, as was their custom in processing individuals being considered for recruitment relative to the April 17, 1961 invasion.

Pursuant to Bureau instructions, Miami is conducting no active investigation of this matter, but will report prosecutive results to the Bureau.

Immediately upon receipt of information concerning this planned raid, Miami notified U.S. Customs, Border Patrol, CIA, FAA, and the Office of the Coordinator of Cuban Affairs, U.S. State Department, Miami.

Copies of this communication are being furnished locally to all the above agencies, and in addition, to INS, G-2, ONI, OSI and the Coast Guard.
