NK 2327-C, the original source reporting this individual to be a member has since stated that the person he had in mind was old when he knew him and is now probably deceased. Source could offer no additional information which would assist in identification.

(FNU) NOVIA 92-1377

This person may be identical with PASQUALE NOVIA who was born in Italy on 1/1/84. In 1953, he resided at 513 South 14th St., Newark, N.J. In 1962 he was reported to be a member of the Essex County Hunting and Fishing Club, Newark. This organization, a gathering place for elderly Italians, is operated by CARMINE BATTAGLIA who is reliably reported to be a Cosa Nostra member. Since NOVIA is 80 years old and is not known to be engaged in criminal activities, no additional investigation concerning him is contemplated.
