WEEKLY SUMMARY

MM 855-PCI advised that the Patio Bridge Club, Miami Beach, Fla., up to the time Sheriff THOMAS KELLY was relieved of his job as Sheriff of Dade County, which was about five months ago, paid off to ELI QUAIN, a reported "bag man" at the rate of \$500.00 per month for the privilege of operating gambling and bookmaking without interference. He also stated that in addition, each of the six Miami Beach policemen on that "beat" receive \$15.00 per week (Miami file 92-218). He further stated that WILLIE BAKER, a New York City gambler, recently gave RUTH GASSEN-HEIMER, operator of the Patio Bridge Club, \$5,000.00, which she used to pay off shylock obligations.

This source also advised that numerous individuals had negotiated with the owners of the "Orange Sun", which operates between Miami and Bimini, relative to the use of that ship for gambling purposes. He advised that he did not know whether the persons were acting individually or together, but commented that ANGELO BRUNO (Miami file 92-139) was interested and he was introduced to the owners of the
