The Bureau's instructions are being followed with vigor and dispatch.

All Agents engaged in the investigation of hoodlum and related activities have again been impressed with the importance of developing in detail the desired information. In contacts with established informants and sources, renewed emphasis is being given to securing up to date data concerning the crime picture in Miami Beach.

As the Bureau is aware, penetrative investigations are going forward on a continuing basis concerning numerous individual members of the hoodlum element in the Miami area, some of whom reside locally on a permanent basis, others of whom visit for a portion of the year during the winter months. Many of these individuals have connections with Miami Beach. In the pursuit of these investigations, the Bureau may be assured that the Agent and Supervisory personnel of this division will develop fully information pertaining to the crime picture in Miami Beach.
