On 5/14/63, DL 146-C (DL 137-551) advised he had learned that subject DAVIS has recently obtained office space in the Mercantile Bank Building, Dallas, with a SMITH REYNOLDS, allegedly an oil man from Tyler, Texas, who has numerous contacts with people who have money. CI further advised that DAVIS and OWENS are "living real high" and appear to have a large amount of cash at their disposal. Informant stated he had heard rumors that they were obtaining this money from crooked poker games in which the victims were wealthy Dallas area residents, who would not make any complaint to local authorities.

On 5/15/63, DL 34-C advised that DOLAN had just recently left Dallas and gone to Hattiesburg, Miss., to take care of some local charges pending against him there. He was to go from Hattiesburg to Mobile, Ala., where he would meet GENE HIGGENSON of Hot Springs, Ark., a "finger man", who had some "scores" lined up in the Mobile area, for DOLAN. HIGGENSON called CI on 5/15/63 from Mobile, stating he had not been contacted by DOLAN yet and was desirous of getting in touch with him. CI advised that he had been unable to locate DOLAN in the Dallas area or any place else after receiving the call from HIGGENSON.
