LV 117-C-TE advised SA CLAIR I. PETERKIN, JR., on 6/2/67 that during the early morning of 5/30/67, MIKE DAVIS of Denver, Colorado, in the company of PHYLLIS MC GUIRE, won \$51,800 on one roll of roulette at the Caesars Palace Casino. Informant advised that JERRY ZAROWITZ, Casino Manager of the Caesars Palace, authorized the removal of the betting limit at the hotel when DAVIS was approximately a \$20,000 loser. Informant stated that DAVIS was a very obnoxious and antagonistic individual while gambling and ZAROWITZ removed the limit in the hope of "burying" DAVIS. Informant stated that PHYLLIS MC GUIRE grabbed the money after DAVIS won in the game and danced around the casino screaming and shouting and generally making a complete fool of herself.(4)

Mr. WILLIAM G. COULTHARD, Attorney at law, former FBI Agent, advised SA M. B. PARKER, on 6/12/67, that he had represented a client who owned a residence at 100 Rancho Circle, Las Vegas, and that the residence was sold to one MIKE DAVIS of Denver, Colorado, for \$170,000. COULTHARD stated it was his understanding that PHYLLIS MC GUIRE was to be shown as the owner of the residence. At the same time of the purchase of this residence an adjoining residence was purchased to be used as a guest house for a purchase price of \$65,000. COULTHARD stated that according to the announced plans, the two houses would be joined by a high fence, and that a new olympic-sized swimming pool, tennis courts, and other features would be constructed. COULTHARD stated further that it was his understanding that checks for payment of both residences were received on 6/9/67, both checks drawn on the Tiger Oil Company. U
