Since date of reairtel, the NYO has made numerous efforts to contact PHYLLIS MC GUIRE with negative results. Direct contacts at MC GUIRE's residence have resulted in contact with her maid, who on each occasion has stated she is unaware of MC GUIRE's whereabouts and date of return to the NY area. u

On 7/5/67, spot checks were conducted at MC GUIRE's residence at various intervals during the day with negative results. u

On 7/6/67, THOMAS A. GRAY, building manager, 525 Park Avenue, NY, NY, MC GUIRE's residence, and ARDEN YOUNG and LAWRENCE MANNING, elevator operators at that address, were interviewed. u

GRAY and YOUNG were unable to furnish any information except that MC GUIRE still resides at that address. MANNING advised that MC GUIRE has been in and out of the NY area during the last two weeks. MANNING stated he last observed MC GUIRE and her current companion, MIKE DAVIS, leave 525 Park Avenue, at approximately 3:30 p.m., 7/5/67. They left this address via chauffeured limousine enroute to John F. Kennedy International Airport. MC GUIRE had 11 pieces of luggage with her upon her departure. MANNING was unaware of MC GUIRE's destination or the limousine service which took her and DAVIS to the airport. U

Review of the file in this case reflects that on 4/18/67, CSNY 23 advised that MC GUIRE would be appearing at a fair in Calgary, Alberta, Canada, from 7/6/67 - 7/15/67. U

OTHER 4

On 6/29/67, [redacted] PCI, American Guild of Variety Artists (AGVA) advised that records of AGVA reflect that MC GUIRE will be appearing for one week at the Diplomat Hotel, Hollywood, Florida, beginning 8/18/67. The identity of PCI is to be protected. PCI can be characterized as an individual, who as a result of her employment, is in a position to furnish information relating to individuals in the entertainment business. U

On 7/6/67, MC GUIRE's maid was again recontacted at which time she advised that MC GUIRE had departed from the NY area, and would be out of this area for approximately one month. On each occasion the maid was contacted, the identity of the contacting agent was made known to her, and she was requested to have MC GUIRE contact the NYO. The maid advised that she has conveyed this message to MC GUIRE on each occasion that she has been contacted by an SA of the NYO. U
