The following information was furnished by a confidential source abroad on February 13, 1964:

GUS ALEX, a United States citizen, in possession of United States passport D-074551, and his paramour, DIETGARD/FUEGER, born December 3, 1938, in Germany, in possession of German passport 4019969 issued by the German Consulate in Chicago, Illinois, on October 16, 1961, arrived in Rome, Italy, on January 7, 1964. They registered at the Hotel Cavalieri Hilton and remained there until January 11, 1964, when they left for an unknown destination. During the time ALEX and FUEGER were in Rome, they were not known to be involved in any suspect activity.
