At 12:45PM FUEGER and her mother checked out of their hotel and using the mother's Volkswagen automobile left Munich toward the south along the Landsbergstrasse. The Bavarian State Police determined that they travelled to House #4 in Riederau which is the home of FUEGER's mother.
