Under date of December 22, 1964, the Bundeskriminalamt (BKA - West German Federal Criminal Police) advised that SUZANNE FUEGER, accompanied by her mother, left Munich, Germany, by Lufthansa Airlines at 12:50 P.M. December 19, 1964, en route to Zurich, Switzerland.	
It will be recalled that FUEGER and her mother traveled from Munich to the mother's home in the very small village of Riederau on the Ammersee (a lake) south of Munich on 11/25/64, after having made hotel reservations in Munich for the nights of December 17 and 18, 1964. The BKA stated that a surveillance of FUEGER and her mother on December 18 and 19 failed to reveal any significant information and they appeared to spend their time in Munich, Germany, in shopping.	
Since EUEGER has departed from Germany and no specific information has been received regarding any plans of the subject to enter this area, active inquiry here is in abeyance but this case is being kept in a pending-inactive status as further inquiry will probably be necessary before the subject and FUEGER return to the United States.	-
