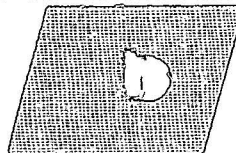
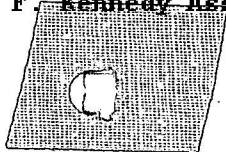

RACE WIRE SERVICE
NEW ORLEANS FAIR GROUNDS

The New Orleans PD revealed that they had placed two Negro officers in disguise *as* undercover employees in the stable area of the New Orleans Fair Grounds and these individuals were able to place race horse wagers at Frank's Bar, 3421 Belfort Street, The Belfort Inn, 3501 Belfort Street, Red Bar and Restaurant, 3405 Belfort Street, and on 1/18/63 they raided and arrested a number of individuals handling booking operations.

Captain PRESLEY TROSCLAIR, Intelligence Division, New Orleans PD, advised that it was his hope that the PD, with these arrests, would curtail the illegal betting of Fair Grounds employees from the stable area with the bookmakers who operate immediately outside the race track adjoining the stable area. Their raid was successful with the exception of locating two individuals known only as JOHN and RICKIE, who had accepted numerous bets, but were not located during the raid. Captain TROSCLAIR requested assistance in identifying these two individuals and based upon information previously furnished by PCI NO 1203 PC, Captain TROSCLAIR was advised that JOHN probably was identical
