On 6/15/66 NIKOLAOS NIKITAKIS, Director, Aliens Directorate, Athens, Greece, advised that GUS ALEX, who possessed U. S. passport number D074551, was presently aboard the Greek vessel SS Stella Solaris on a cruise touring the Aegean Sea. According to NIKITAKIS, ALEX was accompanied by DIETGARD FUEGER, who possessed German passport number B-4019966/27-30/1961. He stated the SS Stella Solaris was scheduled to visit the following Aegean ports:

June 12, 1966 - Rhodes  
 June 13, 1966 - Effisus  
 June 15, 1966 - Istanbul  
 June 16, 1966 - Delos and Mykinos  
 June 17, 1966 - Piraeus
