Re Chicago FD 143 to the Bureau, dated 4/13/62, and Bureau letter to Chicago, dated 4/18/62, requesting an FD 143 to reach the Bureau by 7/10/62. (U)

As the Bureau has been advised, the location for this source was temporarily discontinued in April, 1962, in view of the extensive remodeling being performed on the establishment. Means of access for re-entry was obtained and re-entry was accomplished during July 12, 1962. One mite unit was installed in the same location as the previous unit, however this unit is geared to receive conversation primarily from the rear wall of the main dining room area. It is noted that the remodeling process transformed the old meeting room in the rear to a storage area and no longer contains facilities for dining. It would appear that pertinent conversations will now take place at the rear of the main dining room in a specially constructed booth, complete with telephones and telephone jacks. (U)

Regarding the telephone wiring, the remodeling completely changed the wiring system to the point where the old frame previously used is no longer in use even though the physical setup remains. Physical observation and the study of photographs taken from the outside of the building indicate that the telephone wiring is now connected to the outside of the building. It is felt that if any work performed on the outside of the establishment would possibly draw attention, therefore it is felt necessary to re-enter the establishment at an early date and attempt to activate the mite unit from within. (U)

The Bureau will be kept fully advised and an FD 143 will be submitted upon activation of CG 6486-C*. (U)
